Parade Participation

We are thrilled to continue our tradition of hosting visiting royalty in the Sisters Rodeo Parade, a community favorite that proudly showcases our town's western heritage and spirit.

To streamline arrangements, please ensure that your parade application is submitted no later than **May 15th**. Applications received after this date will not be eligible for participation.

Visiting Royalty at the Rodeo

We are honored by the continued support and presence of rodeo royalty from across the Northwest and beyond. To ensure our performances remain on schedule while maintaining the high-quality production the Sisters Rodeo is known for, we are implementing a new visiting royalty registration process for rodeo performances.

Performance Participation Guidelines

- Each rodeo performance will be limited to 30 visiting royalty participants/individuals.
- Open to Visiting Royalty who hold a current rodeo association title with a scheduled rodeo event date.
- PRCA and NPRA-affiliated State and Regional circuit title holders.

Unfortunately, those not affiliated with the groups above, and those representing clubs and non-rodeo event associations, will not participate in the Grand Entry, but are





- encouraged to engage in personal interactions with the audience, autograph signing at the rodeo grounds, photo opportunities, and the parade.
- Please be advised that we do not provide horses for run-ins; arrangements must be made independently before the event.
- Visiting royalty may participate in up to two (2) performances total throughout the rodeo weekend.
- Participation will be managed through an online registration system on the Sisters Rodeo website on a first-come, first-served basis at <https://sistersrodeo.com/contestant-visiting-royalty/visiting-royalty-pre-entry/>
- The Cowboy Channel will broadcast all performances **LIVE**

Visiting royalty confirmed for a performance will be included in the Grand Entry roll call for that performance.

All visiting royalty, whether participating in Grand Entry or not, are warmly encouraged to:

- Sign autographs
- Interact with fans
- Enjoy the full rodeo weekend experience

These updates were made thoughtfully to balance tradition with the evolving needs of our production and to ensure a positive experience for all involved.

Check-In & Tickets

- Arena closes 4 hours before each rodeo performance.
- You must be checked in no later than 1 hour before each performance for us to get your information to the rodeo announcer in time.





- Promptly, 1 hour before each performance, there will be a mandatory production meeting in the warm-up arena. If you do not attend, you may not be able to be in the grand entry for that performance.
- 30 minutes before the performance, all royalty will be lined up for the grand entry.
- Please do not visit the Rodeo Office or Ticket Office to request complimentary tickets, as they are unable to process these requests.
- Your 2 complimentary tickets per title holder will be emailed to you upon your registration for the performance you will be involved in with the Grand entry.
- All visiting royalty who are not in the grand entry will need to purchase tickets, which are available online at: <https://tickets.sistersrodeo.com/p/tickets>

⚠ *Saturday performances traditionally sell out early. Advance ticket purchases are strongly encouraged.*

Parking & Accommodations

- Front parking areas are reserved for spectators.
- Overnight stays are permitted; however, please help us by keeping your campsite area clean and compact so all participants may be accommodated.
- Information from our Parking Director, Scott Miller: *We want to thank each of you for representing our rodeo with pride and professionalism. Your participation brings tremendous value to our event, and we truly appreciate all the time and effort you put into making it a success.*

Due to recent changes in our event layout and parking logistics, all rodeo queens will need to park in the Forest Service area located on the west side of the rodeo grounds (follow posted signage when you arrive), behind the three cell phone towers. This adjustment will help ensure parking availability for our contestants and provide better access for emergency and support vehicles.



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Please follow the posted signage and directions from parking attendants upon arrival. We appreciate your cooperation and understanding as we make these changes to improve the overall rodeo experience.

Sisters Rodeo Grounds Address: **67637 Highway 20, Bend OR 97703**

Follow Highway 20 through Sisters toward Bend. The grounds are located approximately three miles east of town on the right, next to the Bend/Sisters Garden RV Park.

Arena closes 4 hours before each performance (there is a warm-up arena)

Visiting royalty check-in times will be 1 hour before each performance during the Mandatory Production Meetings held in the warm-up arena. Line-up for Grand Entry will be half an hour before each performance.



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Grand Entry: Run in and line up at either the North or South end of the arena. You will be escorted out of the arena by our SRA Flag Team.

Please make sure your horse can stand during the grand entry (if your horse struggles, you may be asked to attend the next performance without your horse)

After the rodeo, there will be a live band for entertainment over at the Red Rock Corral.
